

U-Turn

2 Chronicles 7:14 NKJV

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Turn - turn back, to return way, road, distance, journey...

Acts 28:26–27 NKJV

saying, 'Go to this people and say: "Hearing you will hear, and shall not understand; And seeing you will see, and not perceive; 27 For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, And their eyes they have closed, Lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, Lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, So that I should heal them."

1. CONFIDENCE

1 John 3:21–23 NKJV

Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God.

22 And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. 23 And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.

2. REPENT

Revelation 2:1–5 NKJV

To the angel of the church of Ephesus write,

'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: 2 "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; 3 and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. 4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. 5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent.

Fallen Greek = *pipto*

A fall; collapse; a downward plummet; a downward fall from a formerly high position.

Repent Greek = *Metanoeo*

To make a change of mind that result in a complete, radical, total change of behavior; a decision to completely change or to entirely turned around in the way that one is thinking, behaving, or living; a total transformation affecting every part of a persons life, both inside and outside, resulting in a behavioral change.

Romans 6:23 NKJV

3. CONFESS

1 John 1:9 NKJV

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

4. RENEW

ROMANS 12:1-2 NKJV
