Genesis 17:1–2 NKJV

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, “I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless. 2 And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly.”

El Shaddai is one of seven covenant names through which God revealed Himself to Israel.

El Shaddai - God Almighty; the all-sufficient one, (the God who knows what He is doing and how to do it.) “The God Who is more than enough.”

Joshua 10:13 NKJV
