# Practical Technique/Helps to Receiving In The Prayer Line

## When standing in line waiting to be prayed for:

- Hands raised as a sign of surrender and worship
- No praying. You are RECEIVING. If you are praying then you are giving out and we are to be in RECEIVING MODE.
- No one touching you - it dissipates the anointing.

\*Pull from your belly - the deep core inside of you. Don't reach with your brain and emotions trying to FEEL something. Pull from your core - from your spirit.

Proverbs 20:27

The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD,  
searching all the inward parts of the belly.

As an act of faith - when you are in the prayer line - do a couple of deep breaths by faith. The word of God refers to the Holy Spirit as the breath of God. Doing a couple of deep breaths by faith primes you to yield to Him as hands are laid on you.

Genesis 2:7

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

## PRIOR to having hands laid on you - pray the following:

Father - I ask that you would help me to LAY HOLD of every impartation. Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may **lay hold** of that for which Christ Jesus has also **laid hold** of me.

**Confess Out Loud the following:**

**Holy Spirit you are called the Helper! I thank you You are helping me to receive when hands are laid on me!**

John 15:26 But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of Truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.

**I believe in the foundational doctrine of laying on of hands.**

Hebrews 6:1,2 **1**Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to [a]perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance of laying on of hands.

**By faith I receive every gift and grace God has for me through the laying on of hands.**

2 Timothy 1:6 Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

**AFTER hands have been laid on you - continue to confess:**

**When hands were laid on me - I received impartations - I will never be the same.**

## **SCRIPTURAL SUPPORT**

### **ACTS 6:1-7 HELPS**

“Now in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution. Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, “It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables. Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word.” And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch, whom they set before the apostles; and when they had prayed, they laid hands on them. Then the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith.”

### **ACTS 13:3 SEPARATION TO MINISTRY**

“Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.” Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away.”

### **ACTS 8:14-19, ACTS 19:6 RECEIVE HOLY GHOST/SPEAK IN TONGUES**

“Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them, who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. And when Simon saw that through the laying on of the apostles’ hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, saying, “Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit.””

“And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.”

### **1 TIMOTHY 4:14, 15 SPIRITUAL GIFTS, IMPARTATIONS, PROPHECY**

“Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership. Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all.”

### **2 TIMOTHY 1:6**

“Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.”

### **HEBREWS 6:2 FOUNDATIONAL DOCTRINE OF THE CHURCH**

“Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.”

### **1 TIMOTHY 5:22 DON'T DO IT HASTILY**

“Do not lay hands on anyone hastily, nor share in other people’s sins; keep yourself pure.”

### **MATTHEW 19:13-15 JESUS BLESSED THE CHILDREN**

“Then little children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and pray, but the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, “Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven.” And He laid His hands on them and departed from there.”

### **MARK 6:5, LUKE 4:40 LAID HANDS ON THE SICK**

“Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.”

“When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.”

### **NUMBERS 27:18-23 APPOINTMENT, ORDINATION, CONSECRATION, MOSES AND JOSHUA**

“And the Lord said to Moses: “Take Joshua the son of Nun with you, a man in whom is the Spirit, and lay your hand on him; set him before Eleazar the priest and before all the congregation, and inaugurate him in their sight. And you shall give some of your authority to him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be obedient. He shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall inquire before the Lord for him by the judgment of the Urim. At his word they shall go out, and at his word they shall come in, he and all the children of Israel with him—all the congregation.” So Moses did as the Lord commanded him. He took Joshua and set him before Eleazar the priest and before all the congregation. And he laid his hands on him and inaugurated him, just as the Lord commanded by the hand of Moses.”

### **LEVITICUS 16:20-22 TRANSFERENCE OF SIN**

““And when he has made an end of atoning for the Holy Place, the tabernacle of meeting, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat. Aaron shall lay both his hands on the head of the live goat, confess over it all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions, concerning all their sins, putting them on the head of the goat, and shall send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a suitable man. The goat shall bear on itself all their iniquities to an uninhabited land; and he shall release the goat in the wilderness.”

### **GENESIS 48:8-20 JACOB (ISRAEL) BLESSES JOSEPH’S SON RIGHT HAND ON EPHRAIM LEFT HAND ON MANASSEH**

“Then Israel saw Joseph’s sons, and said, “Who are these?” And Joseph said to his father, “They are my sons, whom God has given me in this place.” And he said, “Please bring them to me, and I will bless them.” Now the eyes of Israel were dim with age, so that he could not see. Then Joseph brought them near him, and he kissed them and embraced them. And Israel said to Joseph, “I had not thought to see your face; but in fact, God has also shown me your offspring!” So Joseph brought them from beside his knees, and he bowed down with his face to the earth. And Joseph took them both, Ephraim with his right hand toward Israel’s left hand, and Manasseh with his left hand toward Israel’s right hand, and brought them near him. Then Israel stretched out his right hand and laid it on Ephraim’s head, who was the younger, and his left hand on Manasseh’s head, guiding his hands knowingly, for Manasseh was the firstborn. And he blessed Joseph, and said: “God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked,

The God who has fed me all my life long to this day, The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil, Bless the lads; Let my name be named upon them, And the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.” Now when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand on the head of Ephraim, it displeased him; so he took hold of his father’s hand to remove it from Ephraim’s head to Manasseh’s head. And Joseph said to his father, “Not so, my father, for this one is the firstborn; put your right hand on his head.” But his father refused and said, “I know, my son, I know. He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great; but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his descendants shall become a multitude of nations.” So he blessed them that day, saying, “By you Israel will bless, saying, ‘May God make you as Ephraim and as Manasseh!’ ” And thus he set Ephraim before Manasseh.”
