A GOVERNMENT OF PEACE

Two keys to peace.

Gods Government

- **Government**
- **Then Peace**

Only those who are under Gods government can experience gods peace.

There is never a situation that arises where the Peace of God comes up short.
Never not enough

Shalom- Peace Hebrew

completeness, soundness, welfare, peace

- 1 completeness
- 2 safety, soundness
- 3 welfare, health, prosperity
- 4 peace, quiet, tranquillity, contentment
- 5 peace, friendship
 - Of human relationships
 - With God especially in covenant relationship

The word *shalom*, indicates that this dominating peace ultimately gives rise to prosperity in one's soul.

“Peace” in The NT Greek word eirene, *I Ray Nay*

The Greek equivalent for the Hebrew word shalom, which expresses the idea of wholeness, completeness, or **tranquility in the soul that is unaffected by outward circumstances or pressures.**

The word eirene strongly suggests the rule of order in place of chaos.

Luke 2:14 NKJV

Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!”

JESUS IS PEACE

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that **in Me you may have peace**. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

He paid for His Peace to be ours**Isaiah 53:5 NKJV**

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

Psalms 55:18

He has redeemed my soul in peace from the battle that was against me, For there were many against me.

AVOID CONFLICT WITH OTHERS**Colossians 3:12–17 NKJV**

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

John 15:12–13 NKJV

This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one’s life for his friends.

True peace, isn’t the end of a battle, true peace comes when the two opponents reconcile with each other. Removing the opposition and enmity in their hearts.

DEAL WITH CONFLICTING THOUGHTS

Many wonder what they can do to change the feelings of anxiety and they feel when they come under pressure.

1 Peter 5:7 NKJV

casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

2 Corinthians 10:3 NKJV

casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, 6 and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

Look up all these scriptures on peace and meditate upon these and

Philippians 4:6–7 AMPC

Do not fret *or* have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance *and* in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God. 7 And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison *and* mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Isaiah 26:3 NKJV

You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.
